ADMISSIONS POLICY

Possible residents may be referred by self, family, guardian, social workers or other interested parties. All residents will be private pay or Medicaid. Persons considering admission are encouraged to visit the facility for a tour before deciding to be admitted. Appointments are required.

Criteria for admission to this facility are subject to careful evaluation by management:

- Semi-independent persons who are unable to live alone.
- Needing assistance with personal care
- Needing medication supervision.
- Persons needing assistance with dressing - subject to assessment.
- Inadequate nutritional intake.
- Walking with a cane and/or walker – subject to assessment.
- Person needing non-medical supervision or assistance
- Persons who are continent – subject to assessment.

Conditions of people who will **NOT** be admitted to this facility include but are not limited to:

- Persons with risk of elopement
- Moderate dementia with confusion, as assessed by a physician.
- Incontinent or unable to toilet independently
- Persons deemed to be a high fall risk
- Persons having active infections or communicable diseases.
- Verbally or physically abusive to staff, residents or self.
- Requiring constant supervision or restraint.
- Bedbound.
- Persons needing licensed medical staff for regular care needs
- Persons requiring assistance with injecting medications

Sunnyslope Estate will make every effort to carefully screen each resident, in order to ensure that every resident will adapt to the home environment and to accurately assess an appropriate monthly rate. However, every resident is admitted on a temporary basis for up to thirty days.

During these thirty days, if it is determined that the resident will not be admitted on a permanent basis, every effort will be made to accommodate the resident until the responsible party or guardian can locate suitable housing. However, if the resident becomes unmanageable, we reserve the right to discharge the resident immediately.

During these thirty days, if it is determined that the resident will require more care than was originally estimated, the monthly rate will be adjusted accordingly. If an agreement cannot be reached than the responsible party or guardian has the right to relocate the resident, paying only the prorated amount based on the original rate (up to one month). If a refund will be due, it will be prorated from the date the resident's personal belongings are removed from the premises.

If an admitted resident condition shows a significant change beyond the abilities of Sunnyslope Estate, a Physicians assessment will be requested. If it is determined that the resident has developed care needs beyond the scope of our home a 30 day notice will be given to the responsible party asking that the resident be moved to a more appropriate environment. Sunnyslope Estate will make every effort to facilitate this move in the best interest of the resident.
